Other interior improvements include new carpet, paint, window treatments, furnishings, and cozy gas fireplaces. These luxurious condominiums, only 50 yards from the ski slope, also offer daily maid service, convenient shuttle access, and complimentary Aspen airport transportation.

Fact: At 12,510 feet, the Cirque lift has the longest and highest lift-served vertical rise in the U.S.

What's New: Additional double-black diamond terrain has been added in the Hanging Valley Wall. Terrain parks are available for all levels: Funnel - beginner, Coney Glade - intermediate, Velvet Falls - advanced. The superpipe is cut with a state of the art Zaugg pipe cutter. A new more comfortable Campground lift, is also shorter, with a ride time of only 8 1/2 minutes

Location: Within the White River National Forest, adjacent to Snowmass Village and 9 miles from downtown Aspen
