Silver Mountain:

Offers two mountains, 73 trails, 1,600 acres of terrain, 2,200 vertical and more than 300 inches of snow annually, with diverse terrain that spreads skiers across the two mountains so you spend more time skiing and less time in lift lines. Extensive gladed areas and hidden gems make it possible find fresh powder stashes days after the last storm! Indeed, this is Idaho skiing at its finest.

History: Back in the 1880's this was part of the Bunker Hill lode of gold, silver and lead – NOW the Mother Lode of powder and skiing and an incredible year round indoor waterpark. What was once a rough and tumble mining community, full of bigger-than-life characters, now caters to adventure seekers of all ages.

Terrain: 20% beginner, 40% intermediate, 30% advanced, 10% expert. Longest Trail: 2.5 miles

Schweitzer:

Stand at the top and stare at three mountain ranges, Canada and 3 states. You'll be swept away by the surrounding views. Skiing Schweitzer is like having your own private mountain. Home to incredible bowls, chutes, groomed cruisers and some of the best tree skiing in America (over 1200 acres of trees!), Voted one of the top 25 resorts by the readers of Skiing Magazine in their 2007-2008 reader poll!

A modern, efficient network of lifts including one high-speed six-passenger chair, two high-speed quads and 7 other lifts in total whisk skiers and riders to the top in minutes. Lift lines are rare to non-existent and it only gets better from there. Enjoy a variety of terrain from smooth corduroy groomers to wide open bowls and gladed runs. Then return to the top at hair-flying speed thanks in part to Stella (Idaho's only six-person, high-speed lift).
