
## **Donn Bryant**

Citation: We take great pleasure in nominating Donn Bryant for this prestigious Award.

Donn has been a contributor at all levels of organized skiing, including ski club, council and the Far West Ski Association. Donn, a long time member of the Fagowee Ski Club, Capital Ski & Sports Club and Code 3 Ski Club has remained active in club activities long after serving on their Boards. As Club President Donn served several



years as club representative to Sierra Council. He also served as Sierra Council Secretary in 2002-2003 and in his second term as Vice-President, serving from 2003-2005. Donn represented Sierra Council at the FWRA summer races rules meeting at Mammoth in 2000.

Donn's dedicated long term commitment to the sport of skiing continues to be demonstrated with his involvement in Far West Ski Association where he was appointed Chairman of the Councils' Man and Woman of the Year Program in 2001 and continues to serve as its Chairman. Donn has guided several significant changes in the M&W of the Year program. It has been Donn's passion for the program that has influenced and driven the major changes. Donn has served the FWSA Board well as chairman for the past several years.

Donn is continually volunteering to assist and provide his services. In 2003-2005 he served as substitute Head Gatekeeper. From 2002-2005 he actively assisted at all league races with registration, waivers, awards, starter, finisher and pacesetter. He has volunteered at the UNR Ski Swap, Nor Cals, and FWRA Championships every year since 2000. He was awarded the prestigious league's "Top Gun" award for winning the most overall racing points in 2001 and 2002. He race trained in the Masters Race Training Program at Northstar and trained at summer race camps at Mt. Hood since 1998.
